

## **EXCUSED PERIOD/OFF CAMPUS LUNCH POLICY**

This document is intended to communicate to students and parents the expectations for excused periods and off campus lunch.

### **Excused period/Off Campus Lunch options**

- Students may be off campus during their excused or lunch period. Students will be expected to return to their next class on time. Students leaving/returning from an excused period must check in and out in the Main Office. Students arriving late for any reason must also check into the Main Office.

### **Students are not permitted to**

- be in the halls during their excused period.
- attend classes that are not on their schedule.
- use the gym or weight room during their excused period.
- loiter in the parking lot.
- be unsupervised at any Sabin-Schellenberg campus during an excused period.
- ride an SSC shuttle bus during an excused period.

### **Transportation**

It is understood that parent/guardians assume all responsibility for student transportation and liability during the excused/lunch period their student is off campus.

### **Violation of Rules**

Students are expected to follow the Code of Conduct during their excused period. Regular due process and assignment of consequences for violation of school rules will be followed for all incidents occurring during the school day on campus.

### **Waiver**

Students who are off-campus during the 'excused/lunch period' are not under the control or supervision of the school district. **Choosing to be off-campus during the 'excused/lunch period' is voluntary and will expose my child to risks of injuries.** Some of these risks are foreseeable, but some are unforeseeable. Examples of risks include physical injury, emotional injury, property damage, economic loss, noneconomic loss, and deprivation of rights, privileges, and immunities. Also, **some of these risks cannot be eliminated due to the unforeseeable nature of unsupervised activity. I understand that these risks could cause harm to my child, his/her property, and harm to other persons.**

In exchange for allowing my child and me to exercise our right to be off-campus during the 'excused/lunch period,' **both my child and I voluntarily agree to hold harmless, waive, release, indemnify, defend, and discharge the North Clackamas School District ("School District") from all liability and claims arising during my child's time spend off-campus during the 'excused period,' including, but not limited to, liability and claims arising from the District's negligent acts.** I agree to these actions to the fullest

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extent allowed by law. "School District" includes its Board of Directors, the individual members thereof, and its officers, agents, employees, volunteers, and representatives. "Liability and claims" means demands for any value or benefit, such as lawsuits, tort claims, insurance claims, causes of action, fines, fees, and costs (e.g. medical costs and attorney fees). **I further certify and represent that I have the legal authority to waive, discharge, release, and hold harmless the released parties on behalf of myself and the above named participant.**

This Agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by law. If any provision or any part of any provision of this Agreement is held to be invalid or legally unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of this Agreement shall not be affected thereby and shall remain valid and fully enforceable.

**By signing and checking the box on the Policy Acknowledgment form, I certify that I have read this document and fully understand its contents. I understand that I am waiving substantial rights, including the right to sue.** I have read this document in its entirety and I freely and voluntarily assume all risks of such hazards and notwithstanding such, I agree to allow my child to leave campus during the 'excused/lunch period.'"
